JPGS Academic Award Scholarships

Rationale:

- introduced as part of JPGS Golden Jubilee celebrations
- to create a culture in which academic achievement is valued and therefore raise standards throughout the school
- to retain more high achievers into the Sixth Form
- to attract the brightest of students from other British system schools to join JPGS
- to form part of a progression policy throughout the school

IGCSE Scholarships

Outstanding students (internal) - Available from 2018-2019

Up to **two scholarships of 50%** for students likely to achieve 8 or more A* grades, **for the duration of the A Level programme** (recipients would not be eligible for the achievement based awards). Candidates to apply during Y11 after first term report released and award confirmed once mock exam results are published.

Achievement based awards (internal and external) – Available from 2017-2018

The following awards are automatic on the publication of IGCSE results:

- 25% scholarship to awarded students, achieving 8 or more A grades at IGCSE (including 6 or more A*'s)
- 15% scholarship to awarded students, achieving 8 or more A grades at IGCSE (including 4/5 A* grades)
- 10% scholarship awarded to students achieving 8 or more grade A's

AS to A2 Level Scholarships

The following awards are available following publication of AS Level results:

- 20% scholarship awarded to students achieving 4 A grades at AS Level
- 10% scholarship awarded to students achieving 3 A grades at A Level
