1.0 Purpose

To describe the uniform requirements for all pupils in the School.

School uniform is compulsory and applies to all pupils within the School, this must be purchased from the School Uniform Shop to ensure the correct style colours and school logos are used.

5.1 School Uniform Requirements

Nursery to Year 6	School Dress.	Striped School shirt and navy blue shorts.
Nursery to Year 6	School baseball cap	
Nursery to Year 6 (Optional)	Navy Blue Sweatshirt with School emblem.	
Years 7 to 11	Grammar School tie, white School blouse, navy blue skirt or trousers.	Grammar School tie, white School shirt, navy blue trousers with a black or blue belt.
Years 7 to 11 (Optional)	Navy Blue V Neck jumper with School emblem	
Years 12 and 13	6 th form tie, blue School blouse, navy blue skirt or trousers	6 th form tie, blue School shirt, navy blue trousers with a black or blue belt
Year	Girls P.E. Uniform	Boys P.E. Uniform
Nursery to Year 6	White polo shirt with School emblem and navy blue shorts or tracksuit bottoms. Trainers and socks. Swimming – swimming costume, house colour swimming cap, towel and flip flops are required.	
Years 1 to 13	White or House colours polo shirt with School emblem and navy blue shorts or tracksuit bottoms. Trainers and socks. Swimming – swimming costume, house colour swimming cap, towel and flip flops are required.	

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5.2 Other uniform requirements:

Footwear for all pupils	All pupils must wear sensible black leather shoes with plain white, navy blue or black socks that must be visible above the shoe. Trainers, boots, canvas and casual shoes are not permitted.

Clothing	It is suggested that parents label each item of School clothing with their child's name.			
Clothing	School shirts should be tucked in to skirts or trousers and should have the top button fastened. Ties should be neatly tucked under the collar of the School shirt. Skirts must be knee length when seated.			
Hair	Medium to long length hair must be tied back at all times.	Medium to long length hair must be tied back for Science and P.E. lessons.	Hair must not be below collar length and should not be in pupils eyes.	Hair must be off the collar and ears and should not be in pupils eyes.
Hair Accessories	Headbands should be discreet, light blue, white or blue in colour.		No hair accessories permitted.	
Hair Colour	Hair should be one, natural colour. Highlights, streaks and different colours are not allowed. Accessories should only be from the list above.			
Head Scarves	Head scarves should be plain (no visible branding), white or navy blue in colour			
Make Up	Make up should not be worn in School			
Jewellery	A watch is allowed and one pair of plain stud earrings (no stones). No other jewellery is permitted.		Only a watch is allowed to be worn, no other jewellery permitted.	
Valuables	Children should not bring jewellery or any items of value to School. A cash limit of 25 SR is viewed as sensible. The School accepts no responsibility for the loss of any child's personal belongings. Mobile phones are permitted in School but should be turned off whilst in School and should not be used at any time during the School day.			

5.3 House Shirts must be worn in House Assemblies these must also be worn at other House events. These dates will be communicated to pupils as and when they occur.

5.4 It is vital that parents reinforce the need for pupils to comply with the School Uniform Policy. Persistent offenders will be referred to the Heads of Prep and Grammar School or the Head of Sixth Form.

5.5 Pupils will be excluded from School to correct their uniform when necessary.
